Dear Assistant Secretary Myers:


I understand that U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) may be set to issue new "performance-based" detention standards later this month. I have further heard reports that these new standards have already been disseminated to ICE detention facilities and that some of these facilities have begun implementing the new standards.

I also understand that although the current detention standards were developed in collaboration with several non-governmental organizations, a similar collaborative process was not used with respect to the new standards set to be implemented. If our reports regarding the implementation of the new standards are correct, this lack of cooperation with NGOs is deeply concerning.

I respectfully request that ICE immediately provide the House Immigration Subcommittee with a copy of the proposed detention standards and work with Subcommittee staff to set up a briefing on these standards.

Thank you for your timely consideration of this very important matter.
